Regulations & Guidelines PARADE

200 Years & Beyond! THEME:

Celebrating the Bicentennial of The City of Greensboro

Saturday, April 22nd, 2023 Sign-In & Line Up: 11:30am

Parade Start: 1:00pm

- 1. On Parade Day, one representative from each entry must be present to check in, receive entry number and line up information in the Hale County Hospital parking lot.
- 2. The entry form must be received by Main Street Community Festival Committee no later than 5pm on April 14th, 2023 to participate and ensure your entry is accounted for. Late entries are NOT accepted after the late due deadline of April 21st, 2023.
- 3. Walkers are permitted, but will be required to keep pace with the parade's forward movement. All walkers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Early exits from the designated parade are NOT PERMITTED. No one will be allowed to get on or off an entry after the parade has started unless in an emergency.
- 5. Entry numbers MUST be displayed on the right front of the entry vehicle/float OR be held at all times by and group/organization walking.
- 6. Sound effects/music may only be played if in relation to organizations theme.
- 7. All drivers of ANY vehicle/motorcycle/4-wheeler/ATV MUST have a valid driver's license, be at least 18 yrs. old and posses liability vehicle insurance.
- 8. All drivers of any vehicle must stay in the vehicle throughout the duration of the parade; no reckless driving, including spinning tires, burnouts, zig zags or revving engines AT ANY TIME during the parade.
- 9. Please maintain 1 car length spacing at all times.
- 10. Horse entries are required to wear bags. Handlers/owners are responsible to clean up after your own animal, before leaving line up area and on the parade route.

Parade Route:

Line up will be at Hale County Hospital & Greensboro Recreational Center, 508 Greene Street, Greensboro, AL. Starting at Hale County Hospital, we will move down Armory Street, cross State Street, left on College Street, right on First Street, then left onto Main Street, left on Tuscaloosa Street then parade will end on South Street at Lyle's parking lot.
